

About the City

Kalaburagi, formerly known as Gulbarga,

is a historic city in northern Karnataka, serving as the administrative headquarters of Kalaburagi district.

Located approximately 623 km north of Bangalore, it lies in the Deccan Plateau with an elevation ranging from 300 to 750 meters above sea level, along the Bhima River valley. Renamed in 2014, "Kalaburagi" reflects its Kannada roots, meaning "land of stones and thorns." The city boasts a rich heritage, with landmarks like the 14th-century Kalaburagi Fort, Jama Masjid, and Bahmani tombs, earning it a place on UNESCO's tentative World Heritage list under "Monuments and Forts of the Deccan Sultanate." Known as a Sufi city, it hosts significant religious sites such as the Hazrath Khwaja Banda Nawaz Dargah and Sharana Basaveshwara Temple.

Agriculturally, Kalaburagi is renowned as the "Tur bowl of Karnataka," producing 40% of the state's toor dal (pigeon pea), alongside crops like jowar, groundnut, and paddy. The district's black soil and irrigation from the Upper Krishna Project support this productivity. Industrially, it is emerging in cement, textile, leather, and chemical sectors, though it remains relatively backward. With a population of 533,587 (2011 census) and a literacy rate of 67%, the city is a cultural melting pot, with Kannada (55%) and Urdu (36%) as dominant languages. Home to the Central University of Karnataka and a circuit bench of the High Court, Kalaburagi blends historical charm with modern development, making it a growing hub in North Karnataka.

Nearby Attractions

Gulbarga Fort, Khwaja Banda Nawaz Dargah, Sharana Basaveshwara Temple, Chandrampalli Dam, and the Chincholi Wildlife Sanctuary.

Abstract Submission Guidelines

1. Abstract should contain Title, Name(s) of Authors, and Affiliation along with the postal address of Authors, Email address of Presenting Author and body text of abstract.
2. The Title should be specific to reflect the work to be presented, and poster should be related to pharmacy and theme of the conference.
3. The title should be in title case in Metropolis font, size 16.
4. Authors name should be written as surname first followed by name in Metropolis, font size 12, single line spacing, centered and Titled case.
5. The name of presenting author should be marked asterisk.
6. In case of more than one affiliation, each affiliation may be marked by numbering in superscript after the name of author.
7. Number of authors is restricted to 4 people per presentation. All member of group is eligible to get the certificate provided that they all must pay registration fees and attend the conference.
8. Email address of presenting author should be in Italics, Metropolis, font size 12, centered and in lower case.
9. The abstract should be of not more than 200 words, longer submissions will be automatically rejected.
10. The font for the abstract should metropolis font (which can be downloaded from the web) and font size should be 12.
11. The spacing between lines should be 1.5.
12. The abstract should be structured into Background, Objective, Methods, Results and Conclusions.
13. Acceptance will be confirmed later through mail after scrutiny from scientific committee.
14. The accepted abstracts will be provided a code for their entry.

Candidates must clearly state during submission whether they wish to present an E-poster for the abstract that to be emailed to scrmp.conclave2025@gmail.com


